And the first thing I would like to start my story with is to pay tribute to all our sportsmen, who brought victory and world-wide fame to our country.

Great thanks to all of them! We are proud of you! We would not have this great festive occasion without your victories!

All in all Russia won 33 Olympic medals- 13- golden, 11- silver and 9 bronze ones.

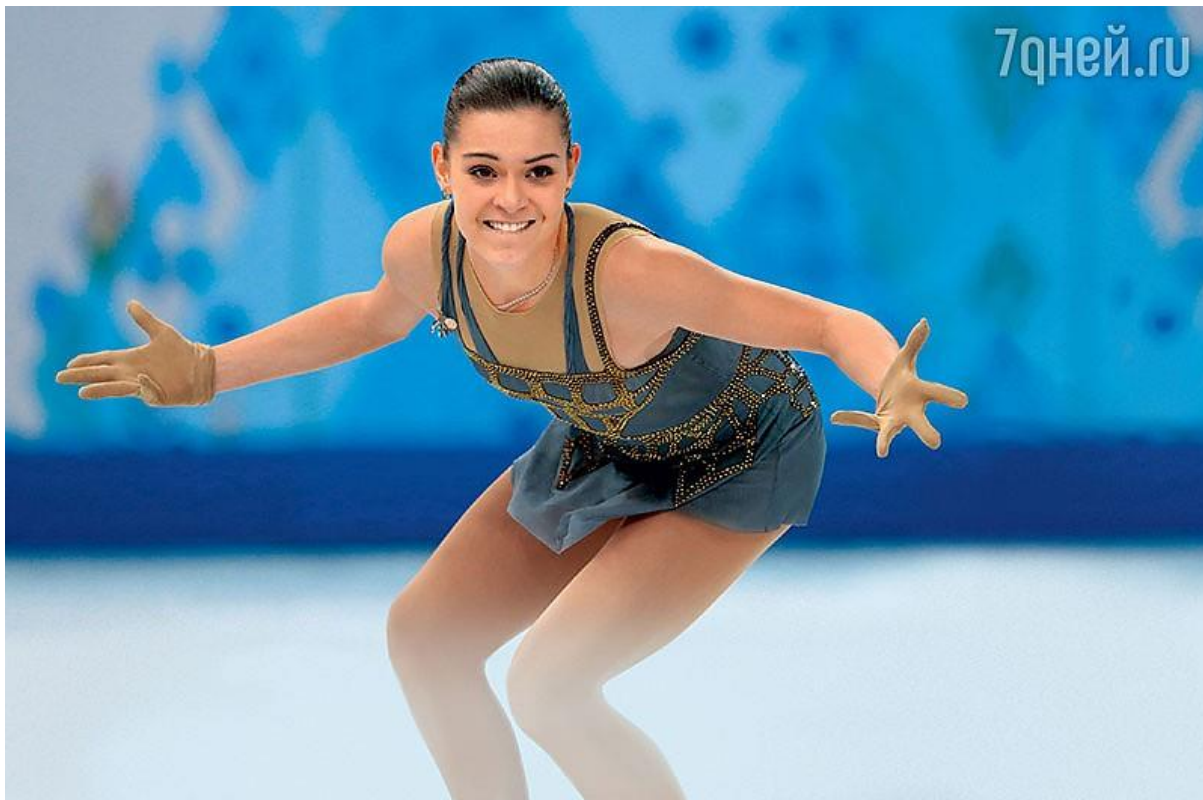

After that – Sport Complex Bolshoy- for hockey matches.



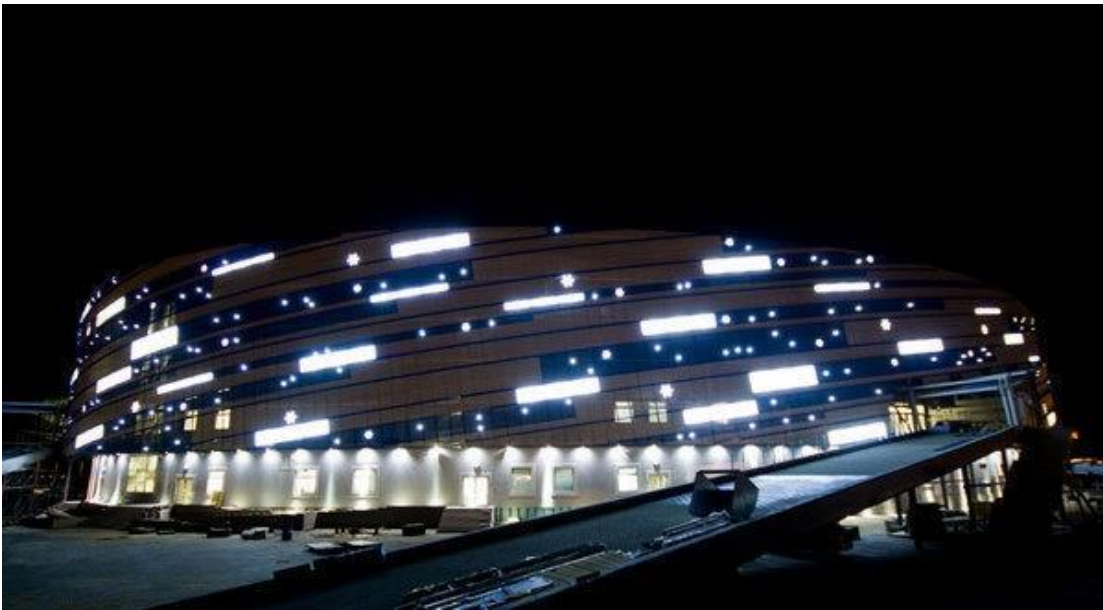
This is the sport complex Iceberg for figure skating.

Curling competitions were held in this building.



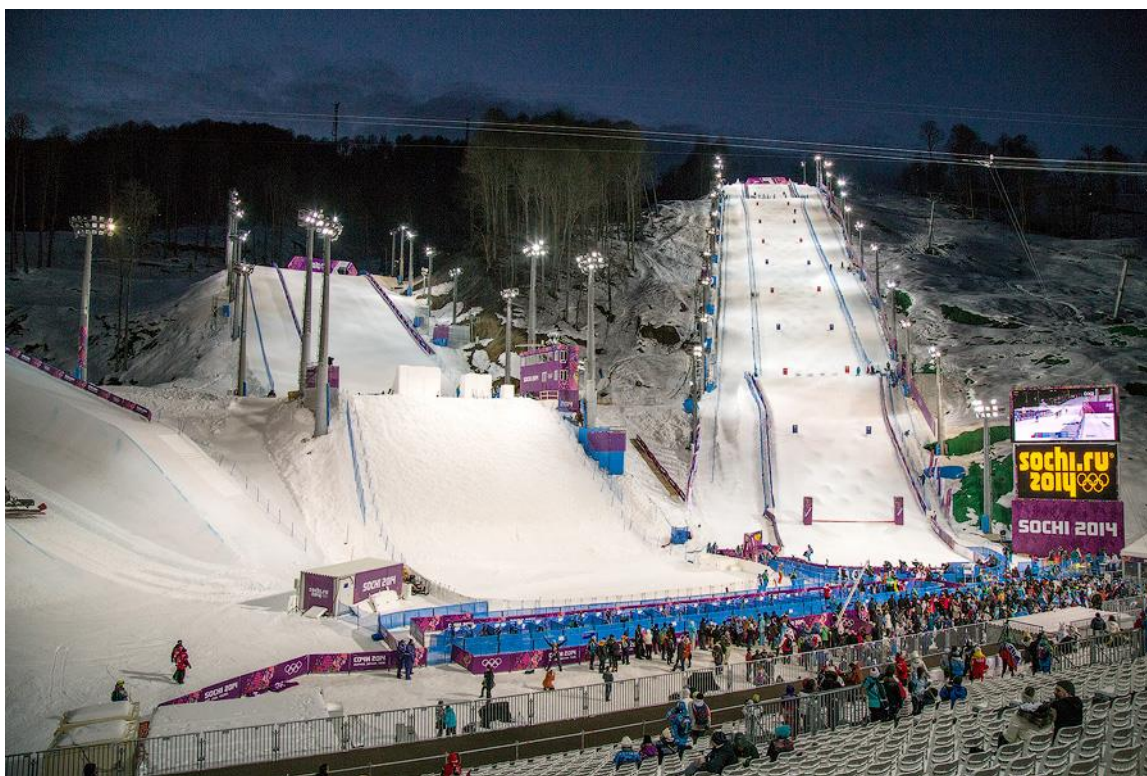
In the very centre there was Medal's Plaza with Olympic flame, where prize ceremonies were held every night.

This is the ski resort Esto Sadok adjacent to the slopes. It runs several kilometres along the mountain river.



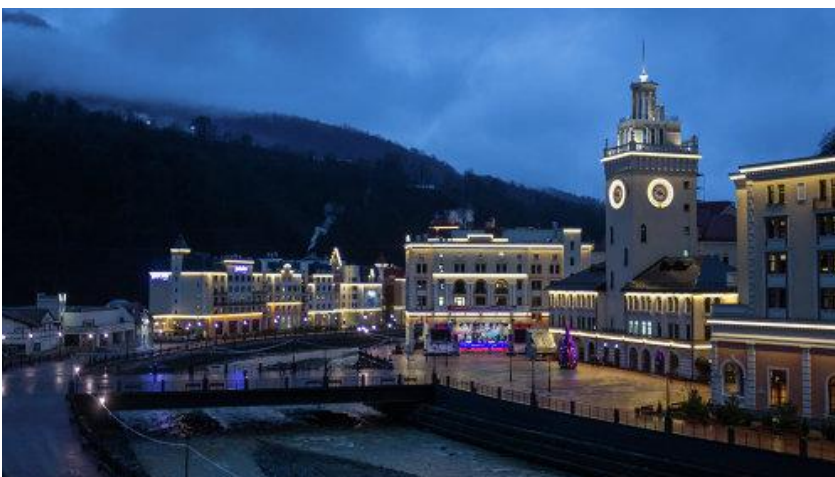
This is the biathlon complex Laura.

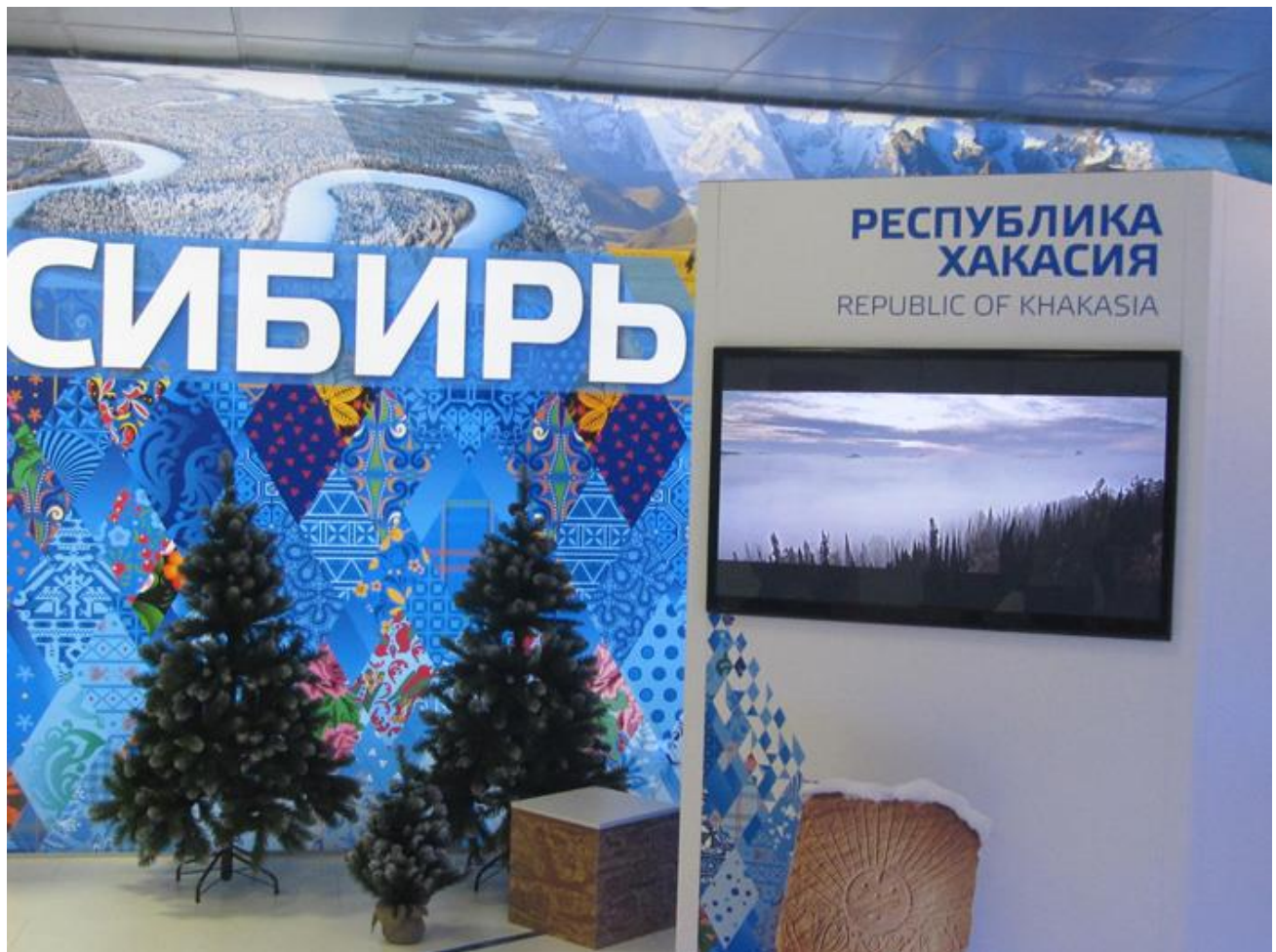

own life. I admire these people. I cried often during the Paralympic Games. But these were tears of their fortitude admiration, not sorrow.







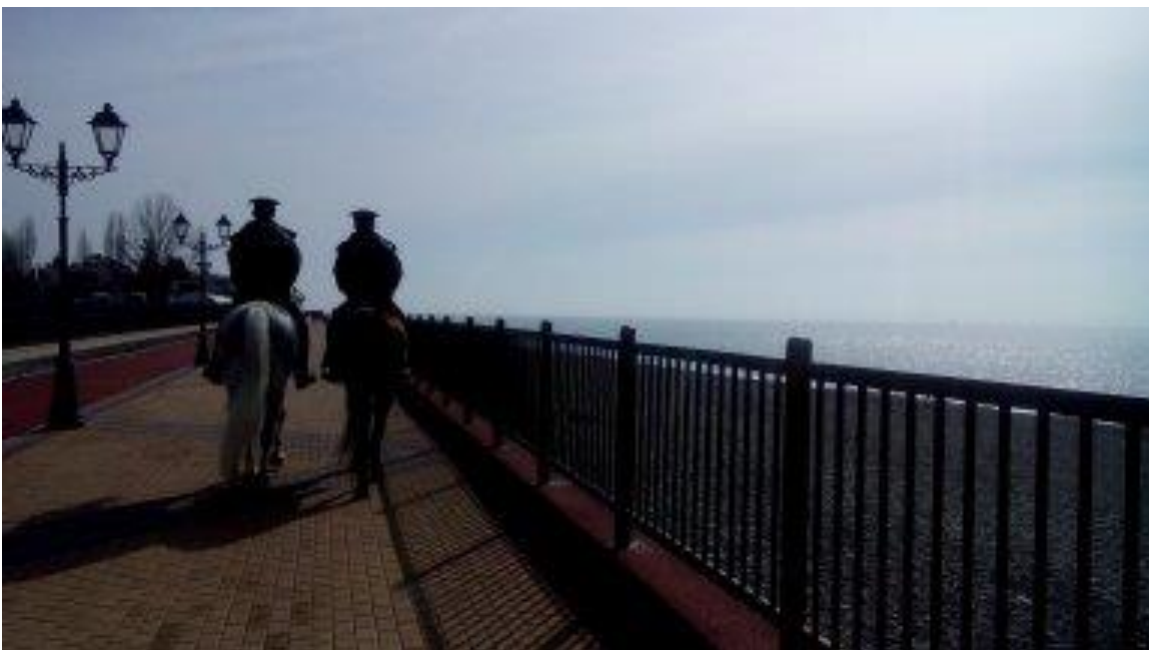
These games finished with triumphal victory of our team- 30 golden medals, 28 silver medals, 22 – bronze ones. All in all Russian team won 80 medals.

And even the Mounted Police was there. It was very exotic.

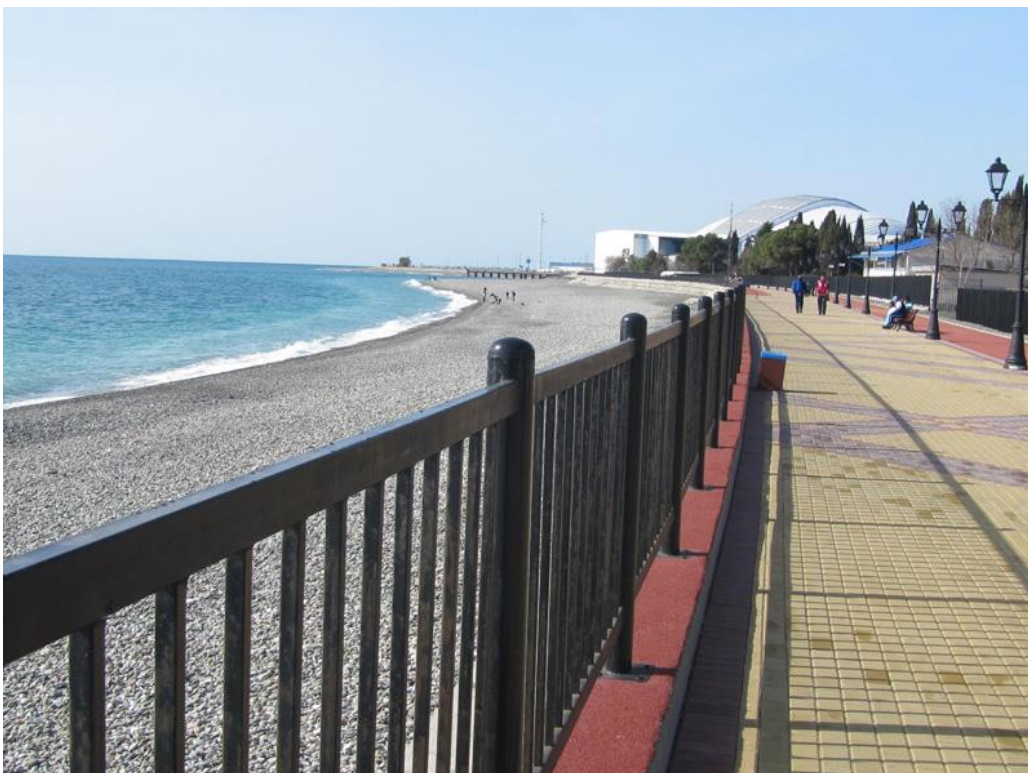
